**I, Officer Julian Manzo, being a duly sworn Police Officer for the City of Edmond, swear the following statements to be true:**

On 06/20/2024 at approximately 1025 hours, I was dispatched to an injury accident at W. Covell Rd. & N Kelly Ave. in Edmond, OK 73003. Upon arrival I observed several vehicles involved in an accident and the Defendant and her 9-year-old daughter outside of her vehicle, a 2016 Red Chevy Trax (OK Tag# [REDACTED]). I also observed and spoke to an involved driver who appeared to be injured and requested medical attention in a white SUV.

Upon making contact with the Defendant, she stated that she became unconscious while driving and woke up in an accident with her daughter asking her what was wrong. I observed the Defendant have blood shot eyes, her pupils pinpoint, erratic behavior (involuntary body movements), and unsteady on her feet. I asked the Defendant if she had any history of fainting, which she said "No." I asked the Defendant if she had taken any medication or drugs that would cause her to faint, which she stated she did not. The Defendant stated that she had been up since 0130 hours. I asked the Defendant if she was willing to take Standardized Field Sobriety Tests to make sure that she was able to drive a vehicle safely. The Defendant stated that she needed to go to the hospital with her daughter, but she would take the test. The Defendant then became very irate and was belligerent toward officers for requesting to take the tests. After repeatedly asking the Defendant to focus on me and to listen to the instructions, she threw her belongings on the ground and said she was ready for the tests. While conducting the series of tests, I observed multiple clues of intoxication.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I placed the Defendant under arrest at 1109 hours for Driving Under the Influence. I then transported the Defendant to the Edmond City Jail for booking procedures. While at the jail I read the Defendant implied consent at approximately 1120 hours and offered her a blood test. The Defendant consented to taking the state's blood test. I then transported the Defendant to OU Medical Edmond for the state's blood draw test. While at OU Medical Edmond, I read the Defendant Miranda at approximately 1136 hours. The Defendant agreed to answer questions and speak to me. While at the hospital, the Defendant stated that she was prescribed different medications and some of the labels do have warning labels that state they cause drowsiness and caution operating a motor vehicle. The Defendant also stated that she was afraid that some of the prescription medication would show in her system as amphetamines in the blood test. I asked the Defendant if she had taken any other drugs which she said that she consumed marijuana three days ago but nothing else. The Defendant's daughter was ultimately transported to OU Children's by ambulance.

I believe that based on the above facts and circumstances that sufficient probable cause exists for the filing of criminal charges of (MISD) Personal Injury Accident While Under the Influence (47OS11-904A1) and Child Endangerment (21OS852.1). This crime occurred in the County of Oklahoma.
