Dear Sheriff Johnson:

Please accept this letter as an official request from OMES to investigate the complaint submitted by Becky Carson on July 25, 2025, to the OMES General Counsel.

Ms. Carson specifically stated in her complaint that she was "subjected to pornographic images on the monitor of Ryan Walters."

OMES is requesting your office perform the investigation to determine if any criminal statutes have been violated including, but not limited to, 21 O.S. Section 1021(A)(3) which prohibits every person from knowingly or willingly distributing, knowingly downloading on a computer, or exhibiting any obscene material. 21 O.S. Section 1021(E) states, "For purposes of this section, 'downloading on a computer' means electronically transferring an electronic file from one computer or electronic media to another computer or electronic media."

An investigation would have to be conducted to determine intent and the parties' involved.

OMES submitted the complaint to OSBI. However, pursuant to 74 O.S. Section 1502 and Section 1505, OSBI lacks the power and duty to initiate an investigation at the request of a State Department of Education Board Member or from a referral by OMES.

On July 29, 2025, I was advised the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office was requested to assist in an investigation by the Oklahoma Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES).

Two board members, Becky Carson, and Ryan Deathridge, alleged to have witnessed nude/explicit videos or images on Ryan Walters office TV during an executive school board session.

The morning of July 29th, OCSO investigations met with OMES discussing the alleged events. Later the same day investigations returned for a meeting with Walters in his office for an investigation regarding his TV, its streaming, Airplay, mirroring, and other abilities to view video content.

The Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigations (OSBI) were asked to investigate an incident that took place on July 24, 2025, during a State Board of Education Meeting. It was reported by two separate State Board of Education (Board) members that while they were in executive session, in the meeting area of State Superintendent Ryan Walters' office, at the Oklahoma State Board of Education, that there was nudity being displayed on the television in Walters' office. One witness stated he noticed the nudity on the television during this portion of the meeting and hoped it would end. Another witness noticed the nudity and abruptly commented that there was nudity on the television. It was reported there were multiple nude females displayed on the television. One witness described it as full-frontal nudity and believed it to be from the 1970's or 1980's era. After making this declaration it was reported that Walters went into that area and turned off the television. Walters stated he did not notice what was on the television and did not investigate due to the meeting currently taking place. Walters stated he usually has Fox News on the television and believes that day he would have turned to that network before the meeting.

On July 28, 2025, investigators with OCSO went to Walters' office with his general counsel, members of the IT department, Oklahoma Office of Management and Enterprise Services general counsel (OMES) and an independent company, Alias Cyber Security. During this the television in Walters' office was looked at for possible ways the images mentioned above could have been displayed that day. It was noted this television is a Samsung Smart TV, and it was connected to the internet. It was also noted the television was connected to a working Cox Cable component that provides television service through Cox. Additionally, smart TV's have applications (apps) that provide video content, referred to as streaming, and they also have the capability to receive content from cellular telephones, tablets and some computers. This is often referred to as casting, screen mirroring or AirPlay. When the television was turned on it displayed channel number 1204. It was learned this channel is a Samsung TV Plus channel named Movie Hub Action. This is a free television service that streams to the television via the internet. If a television is tuned to a channel like this it will play the scheduled content. After that movie is concluded it then will play the next scheduled movie. It does not require user intervention to start a movie. It resembles more of a traditional broadcast channel in this regard.

On this day, investigators began gathering information about Samsung content, programming for that day, and whether this service displays nudity or not. Initial findings indicated that nudity is blurred when a movie being broadcast via this service contains this type of content.

Superintendent Ryan Walters was interviewed on July 29, 2025. The following is a summary of the interview. The interview was recorded on Investigator Paul Harmon's BWC. This summary does not memorialize each statement. Reference the recorded interview and/or other supplements for further information. Walters stated there was a board meeting (Oklahoma State Board of Education) on July 24, 2025, at 9:30 am. He believed at approximately 11:15 am the board would have entered the executive session portion of the meeting. When they broke into the executive session, he mentioned to the Board that there was food on his desk for them to eat, and he needed to go speak to the attorneys and witnesses. Walters stated this took approximately ten (10) minutes, then he informed the board that these witnesses will be the first to speak. Walters stated this took approximately ten to twenty minutes (10-20). After this they began talking about the legal process of the pending vote that was to take place. Walters stated that during this portion of the meeting, Becky Carson made a remark that there was nudity or a naked person on the television. Walters stated his back was toward the television, and he hadn't been able to see it. Walters stated the remote wasn't on the table he thought it would be on and located it on his desk, which is where all the food was placed. He then returned to the board meeting and stated that this incident did not come up again

during the meeting. Walters stated that he did not see any nudity on the television and thought it showed two people talking, then turned the television off. Walters stated the meeting continued while he was in the process of turning off the television. Walters stated this is the most ridiculous thing he has seen in his life. Walters stated he always has the television on Fox News and streaming isn't possible on this television, according to OMES (Office of Management and Enterprise Services). Walters was asked if he always has the television on a news channel and was then alerted to nudity being on his television, why wouldn't he verify what was being displayed. Walters stated he didn't know what was on the television, so he turned it off. It was then explained you could take a pause and confirm it was a news station. Walters stated he doesn't normally have the television on during a meeting. When he turned around and saw there wasn't nudity he recognized the television as a distraction, and it needed to be turned off. Walters explained that this incident didn't seem like a big deal at the moment and the meeting resumed without further discussion.

Walters explained that when a Board meeting is taking place it is a hectic day. He is escorted by Oklahoma State Troopers who meet him at his car then escort him into his office. On this day there were 7 (seven) Troopers on the escort detail. After escorting him to his office, Walters makes sure they have what is needed for the board meeting and at least some of the Troopers are just outside his office. Walters stated if he were to walk down the hallway the Troopers would be present.

On July 29, 2025, Investigator Harmon interviewed Board Member, Becky Carson. Carson is a State Board of Education member and was present during the meeting on July 24, 2025. Below is a summary of this interview. Refer to additional supplements and/or the video recording for further. Carson stated after the open portion of the meeting they adjourned to executive session which takes place in Walters' office. She described this office as being in the shape of an "L". Carson described the seating arrangements and how she was able to view the television from where she was sitting. Carson stated she noticed the television was on when she came into the office but didn't notice what was on the television. As the meeting progressed, she noticed something on the television that shouldn't be there, and she began questioning herself as to what she thought she observed. She initially thought maybe what she was perceiving as nudity was women wearing bodysuits then she quickly noticed breasts and pubic hair. Carson described this as shocking and nerve-racking. After seeing nudity on the television, Carson remarked about the content on the television and stated it needed to be turned off. Carson stated she believed this to be something that wasn't recently produced, referred to as vintage, due to the coloration of the content. Carson believes this incident may have been an hour after they began the executive session. Carson stated as a teacher (ret) and a Christian she felt as though she had been exposed to something that she did not want to be a part of and felt violated.

Board Member, Ryan Deathridge was interviewed on July 30, 2025. This interview was recorded on Investigator Harmon's BWC. The following is a summary of the interview. It does not memorialize each statement. For further context refer to the interview supplement or the video recording. Deathridge described that where he was sitting he was able to see the television in Walters' office and this all took place in the executive session portion of the Board meeting. As a witness was providing testimony he noticed the television was on, and he observed nude women on the screen. Deathridge believed this to be a movie but stated it was not a "porno" (pornographic movie). Deathridge stated there was no sexual intercourse taking place. Deathridge stated this content was on the television during the testimony of two different people. Deathridge stated he was hoping the content would go off, and he was hoping no one would see it. He had planned to discuss what he had witnessed with Walters after the meeting had concluded. Deathridge stated that at some point later, Mrs. Carson noticed the television and remarked about during the meeting. Deathridge stated Walters did get up, he did not notice his expression, and did not see him messing with the remote. Deathridge stated that if this situation had happened to him when he would have returned to the table he would have apologized for what had taken place, but Walters didn't do this. Deathridge stated he believed the Board attorney said lets regain focus, and they resumed business and no one said anything about what had taken place. Deathridge stated he believed the content to be a movie and that it looked like it was from the 1970's or early 1980's. Deathridge stated it was grainy, and the colors were not vibrant like a modern program. Deathridge stated he could not hear any audio. Deathridge stated there was content that did not contain nudity and it appeared to be a

"regular movie". Deathridge stated there was a beach scene and a scene with a massage table. Deathridge also stated the females were wearing towels at one point.

Interviews were conducted with other attendees of the meeting. No other witnesses reported seeing any nude content on the television.

The morning of July 30, 2025, I contacted the OSBI regarding assistance with this investigation. Discussions were had regarding obtaining the electronic devices issued to Superintendent Walters from the state, including the television witnesses reported seeing nudity, as well as his personal cellular telephone. It was arranged that any devices obtained would be examined by OSBI as soon as possible, so they could be returned in a timely manner and limit any disruptions to a minimum. Investigator Paul Harmon sent a request to Jacki Phelps, via email, at approximately 11:05am on this day (attached).

The morning of August 1, 2025, there had been no response to the first request. At approximately 7:52am I sent a second request to Jacki Phelps requesting the electronic devices (attached).

On August 5, 2025, I received a response from the above-mentioned requests. This came from John Cannon who stated his office was representing Superintendent Walters in these matters and requested fourteen (14) days to respond to these requests and to advise if this time frame was acceptable. I responded this same day (attached) saying this seemed like a long time to process this request and the state issued equipment should be readily available. I also reiterated that this would be done in a timely fashion. This same day OCSO began coordinating with OSBI about executing a search warrant for all state issued devices as well as Walters' personal cell phone. The probable cause for the search warrant was drafted but not signed or executed.

Agent Adam York (OSBI), and I began making additional efforts to obtain the programming schedule from Samsung. Agent York contacted Samsung about this information.

At approximately 1830 on this day I interviewed Ryan Deathridge, one of the board members who came forward with claims of seeing nudity on the television in Ryan Walters' office. This interview was recorded on my BWC and has been uploaded into the digital evidence server for Axon. The following is a summary of the interview. It does not memorialize each statement. Prior to the interview, Deathridge brought up concerns about being referred to as a liar by Ryan Walters. Deathridge was referencing a recent news article from that day when Walters had acknowledged the description of the movie "The Protector" fit what he saw when he noticed the television. Prior to the interview, Agent York had provided me with two (2) different clips of this movie, both containing unedited nudity. I asked Deathridge to view these clips to help determine if this might have been what he saw on Walters' television on July 24, 2025. The first clip is a scene from the movie that centers around massage tables. As he was watching the first clip, Deathridge stated he remembered one of the actors. As the scene progressed, Deathridge stated he thought he remembered this and that he did remember the table (massage). After watching the provided clips Deathridge stated he felt pretty comfortable this was what he viewed on Walters' television. Deathridge confirmed that he had not viewed this content prior to our interview. A short while later the interview was concluded.

On the morning of August 6, 2025, I interviewed Becky Carson, one of the board members who came forward with claims of seeing nudity on the television in Ryan Walters' office. This interview was recorded on my BWC and has been uploaded into the digital evidence server for Axon. The following is a summary of the interview. It does not memorialize each statement. Carson was shown the same two (2) clips that were shown to Mr. Deathridge. The first clip is a scene that takes place around a massage table that does contain nudity. At the conclusion of this video clip Carson stated this is not what she saw on the television. The second (2nd) clip shown to Carson takes place in a warehouse type setting and shows several women exit a van wearing white coats. They remove these coats and are then nude. They then climb a ladder in the background while two men are talking in the foreground. Carson stated

she did not recognize this exact scene but thought the women looked like the women she saw on the television and stated this had the overall look of what she saw on the television. A third (3rd) clip was shown to Carson. This clip is a continuation of the previous clip. After watching this clip, Carson stated she was fairly comfortable saying this was probably what she saw.

On August 6, 2025, I received another response from Mr. Cannon (attached). He stated he was doing his due diligence in this matter and would respond as soon as possible. Additionally, he included three (3) links to new stories that had been recently published after the Oklahoma Speaker of the House made contact with Samsung. These are in reference to the possibility the movie playing in Walters' office had been identified as a rated R movie titled "The Protector".

On this day I reached out to Samsung again to obtain programing information for July 24, 2025. I emailed Eric Tamarkin from Samsung. This is the same person, Kyle Hilbert, the Speaker of the House for the Oklahoma House of Representatives had previously contacted. Additionally, I emailed the Samsung subpoena processing center (attached). I did not receive responses to either of these emails.

On August 7, 2025, Agent York prepared a subpoena to obtain the programing data from Samsung. Prior to serving this order Agent York spoke with a representative at Samsung. York explained to me that Samsung executives were discussing the possibility of releasing the requested information without a court order. On this same day, Jim Hogg, Director of Security and Management for Samsung, contacted Agent York and provided the scheduled programming for July 24, 2025. His email states: "We can confirm The Protector (1985) aired on the Samsung TV Plus channel 1204 on July 24 from 11:01 am - 12:59 pm CT. This film does contain nudity. The Foreigner (2017) aired from 12:59 am CT - 3:05 pm CT. Samsung strives to deliver a range of content that viewers would find appropriate."

It is known the board meeting that took place on July 24, 2025, began at 09:30 am. It is believed the channel that was on that day was 1204, Samsung Action Movie Hub. It was noted on July 28, 2025, that when his television was powered on the channel displayed was this same channel. Walters claimed no one had done anything to the television since the board meeting. If this channel was on prior to the board meeting, the movie being broadcast at that time would have concluded by the time the Board Meeting went into executive session. Samsung officials state "The Protector" began airing on this date at 11:01 am, prior to the Board moving into executive session. Using the recording of this meeting via Facebook, it appears the regular meeting concluded at 11:22 am. It is known Board members took a short break, grabbed food and/or used the restroom before beginning the executive session. The nudity in this film takes place approximately 35 minutes into the movie then again approximately another 30 minutes later. It is known Board Member Deathridge first noticed the nudity on the television and did not say anything. It was estimated Board Member Carson noticed the nudity approximately 20 - 30 minutes later and then brought it up to the Board. This time frame would be congruent with the time frame of the movie and when nudity scenes would have been taking place. Being that this movie began while the Board was in their regular meeting, in a different part of the building there is no evidence to suggest Superintendent Walters made a conscience effort to have this playing in his office. It is believed by investigators this movie was in fact playing in Walters' office and all the evidence obtained in this investigation suggest the playing of this movie was unintentional.

The movie clips, and all other evidence, is being stored in the Axon digital evidence server.

Case Assignment:

On July 28, 2025, I was requested to attend a meeting at the Office of Management and Enterprise Services or also known as OMES for the State of Oklahoma. I was advised by Undersheriff Anderson that he, Sheriff Johnson and I would be meeting with General Counsel Tracy Osburn regarding State Superintendent Ryan Walters. Undersheriff Anderson stated OMES received a complaint regarding inappropriate video playing on Walters TV while they were having an education board meeting.

On July 28, 2025, I met with Tracy Osburn with OMES, Sheriff Johnson and Undersheriff Anderson at OMES. Osburn stated she was requesting the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office to investigate the complaint she had received. Osburn stated due to the state house and senate not being in session OSBI was unable to work the case. We discussed the formality of the request, such as Osburn sending a letter requesting our assistance. (letter from Osburn is attached to Axon).

At the completion of the meeting, I called my partner Lt. Belanger and advised him what we had. I advised Lt. Belanger I had just ended a meeting with OMES, and they were sending the request over. I also shared the complaint I received from Osburn from the education board member. Lt. Belanger and I then began planning our next steps in the investigation

Forensic investigation on Walters TV. (See attached video on Axon).

On July 28, 2025, at 1530 hours I was contacted and requested to be at SI Walters' office. I was advised OMES had hired an outside firm to do forensic checks on SI Walters' television in his office. I contacted Lt. Belanger, and he agreed to meet me there. I also had Deputy J. Page who attended the meeting go as well.

On arrival at the Department of Education, I was met by Osburn. Osburn introduced me to SI Walters' General Counsel Jacki Phelps. We were then escorted to SI Walters' office where we were introduced to him. The private forensic company then began investigating SI Walters' TV, cable box, antenna, and DVD player. Lt. Belanger and Dep. Page stayed with the forensic IT examiners, while I spoke to SI Walters and Jacki Phelps. I began asking where everyone had been located during their executive meeting. SI Walters began telling me where each person sat. I then drew a small rough sketch of the room and table and had Walters and Phelps point at the locations of everyone in the room and their contact information. SI Walters also stated during the meeting they had a mother of a student and the superintendent of Bethany schools come into the meeting about a transfer issue. I then asked if they had contact info for anyone. SI Walters was able to provide approximately 4 four of the individuals contact info. I then took pictures (attached to Axon) of the meeting table. (See forensic report and video of forensic tests being conducted on Axon).

Initial Interview Becky Carson:

On July 29, 2025, at approximately 1153 hours, Carson came to the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office for her initial interview. I started off the interview by introducing myself and letting Carson know that the interview would be recorded. Carson stated she understood. I then gathered basic information for the report.

I then asked Carson to tell me exactly what had happened. Carson stated they had finished the open portion of the board of education meeting. Carson stated they went to SI Walters office to conduct the executive session board meeting. Carson then described SI Walters office as shaped as an L. Carson described where the TV was located and where she was seated. Carson stated she and Ryan Deathridge were seated where they could see the TV. Carson stated there were other members on the opposite side of the table which couldn't see the TV and SI Walters back was turned to the TV.

Carson stated they had a parent and Superintendent come into to discuss a transfer appeal. Carson went on to say when she came into the office, she noticed the TV on, but the sound was off, and she didn't remember seeing what was on TV. I asked if it was normal for the TV to be on during the meetings. Carson stated she didn't believe it had ever been on during their meetings. Carson stated the parent and superintendent ad said their thing, so the board began discussing certificate revocations. Carson stated she went to ask SI Walters a question, so she looked at him, Carson says this is when she observed naked females on the TV.

Carson said when she first saw the naked females, she questioned what she was seeing, and that all the women looked the same, such as hairstyle and such. Carson stated the video looked like it was "vintage." Carson stated she thought maybe the women were wearing full bodysuits. Carson stated she continued to watch and then realized she could see the females breast and pubic hair. Carson stated as a woman she felt violated, especially in a government officials office. Carson stated she confronted SI Walters about what was on his TV. Carson stated SI Walters got up and saw the TV and said what is that? Carson went on to say Walters was trying to turn it off and said again what is that, and I can't turn it off. Carson stated she told SI Walters to turn it off now, and he finally was able to turn it off. Carson stated that was the end of the story and that Walters never discussed it again, so she filed the complaint.

Conclusion of facts:

During the investigation it was found the 1985 rated R movie "The Protector" with Jackie Chan was unintentionally playing during the executive board meeting. In this movie multiple nude women clips were found and showed to the reporting parties. Reporting party Deathridge stated it appeared to look like what he had seen on SI Walters TV. Carson stated she was unsure.

Samsung Electronics of America was contacted, and they stated "The Protector" was playing at the time the executive board was occurring. Samsung was also able to say at the approximate time frame of the meeting the nude scenes would have been showing. Samsung stated the movie would have been playing on Samsung channel 1204. During the forensic audit conducted, SI Walters TV when turned on was on channel 1204.

During the several interviews conducted, Carson and Deathridge were the only individuals who witnessed the nudity on TV. Both Carson and Deathridge's descriptions were both very similar. Carson and Deathridge both stated it was an older movie, but not porn. Both described several women walking around with their "breast" showing and "pubic hair" or "bush" showing. When investigators watched "The Protector" they observed in multiple scenes women walking completely nude. One scene showed what appeared to be a massage scene, like stated by reporting parties. Both Carson and Deathridge stated this made them feel uncomfortable, due to being in the executive board meeting.

Both Carson and Deathridge stated Carson told SI Walters what was on the TV, and he fumbled around trying to locate the remote to turn it off. Carson and Deathridge stated nothing was said by SI Walters about what was on, but the attorney advised they needed to get back to work. During Walters interview he denied seeing anything inappropriate and stated he only has Fox News typically playing on the TV. SI Walters, during the forensic investigation of the TV produced multiple remotes which were all checked. It was also found there were no parental locks activated on SI Walters TV, which would allow for a situation like this to occur.

The evidence shows there was nudity on SI Walters TV during the executive board meeting. It also shows this was unintentional and an isolated incident. During multiple TV interviews SI Walters denied this occurring and stated the reporting parties were sent by the Governor to do this. No evidence was found that the Governor had anything to do with this, nor was Carson or Deathridge sent to do this by the Governor. End of report.

Superintendent Ryan Walters was interviewed on July 29, 2025, at approximately 10:25am. The interview was recorded on Investigator Harmon's BWC. The recording is 22:54 in length. The following is a summary of the interview. It does not memorialize every statement made. For further context, refer to the archived recording.

Walters stated the board meeting started at 0930 in the boardroom. This took place until roughly 1115 on July 24, 2025. The meeting is streamed live and there is media present. When the regular meeting ended, and they went into executive session he told the Board there was food available and to help themselves. He then told them he was going to locate the attorneys and witnesses there were needed for the executive session. Walters spoke to the witnesses and told them they were going to go at the beginning of this session and began walking them through the process that was about to take place. This took about 10 minutes. He then went into the boardroom and notified the board of the order of the witnesses. Each of these witnesses took approximately 5-10 minutes then they began talking about the legal procedure for the pending vote. During that time Board Member Carson commented that there was nudity or naked people on the TV. Walters' back was to the TV. He didn't know it was on. He got the remote from his desk with all the food and turned it off. He returned to the meeting and stated there was not any other discussion about this incident. Walters stated he did not see any nudity on the TV and believed it was two people talking. Walters stated he did not remember turning the TV on that morning, and it was normal that someone from his staff would turn on Fox News for him. Walter's stated he is escorted by Oklahoma State Troopers on Board Meeting days. He stated meeting days are usually chaotic. Prior to the Board Meeting he had a meeting ensuring they had all the documents, comments for the meeting, and are there any legal concerns. Walters stated that the Troopers meet him at his car and walk him to his office then stay outside his office and keep eyes on him as he moves around the building. Walters believed he arrived at the building just after 9:00am. After arriving to the office on board meeting days he is not alone, as the Troopers are always nearby. Walters explained that there are several things that have to be handled or addressed on board meeting days, prior to the meeting. Walters stated he was not able to differentiate if the content was a news broadcast or a movie. Walters stated the meeting continued while he walked away to turn the TV off. Walters stated that this (the allegations) is the most ridiculous thing he's ever seen. It is cable network, and he never has it on anything other than Fox News. Walters stated he left the Board Members alone for 10 - 15 minutes, and he comes in and there is no problem. Walters stated this is the most absurd thing he has seen in his life and he can't stream on this TV. I asked Walters why he wouldn't point out to the Board that it was only Fox News. Walters stated he didn't know what was on the TV, and he normally doesn't have the TV on during a meeting. Walters stated he recognized the TV as a distraction and turned it off. Walters stated while he was looking for the remote and turning the TV off the meeting was still taking place, and he returned to the meeting. A short while later the interview was concluded.

Ryan Deathridge was interviewed on July 30, 2025, at approximately 4:20 pm. The interview was recorded on Investigator Harmon's BWC. The recording is 22:54 in length. The following is a summary of the interview. It does not memorialize every statement made. For further context, refer to the archived recording.

Deathridge is an Oklahoma State Board of Education Board Member. Deathridge stated they had their regular meeting then went into executive session. Deathridge explained where he was seated and how he could see the TV from this spot. As there is discussion about a school transfer he was paying attention to the witness, who would have been in the same direction as the TV from him. Deathridge stated that Fox News is usually on the TV and on this day it was something different. Deathridge stated it appeared to be a movie setting but it was not a porno (pornographic movie). Deathridge stated this content was on through both witnesses, and he was hoping it would go off and no one would see it. Deathridge stated he had planned to talk to Superintendent Walters after the meeting about what was on the TV. Deathridge estimated they were about 15-20 minutes into the meeting when Board Member Becky Carson noticed it and said something. Deathridge stated Walters got up from the meeting (to turn the TV off). Deathridge expected Walters to be apologetic, which didn't happen. The Board attorney refocused the Board, and they resumed the meeting. Deathridge believed the content to be a movie from the 70's or early 80's and believed it to be somewhat grainy. Deathridge stated there was a scene that had a massage table and the females were wearing towels. Deathridge stated there was no nudity the whole time, and he believed it to be a regular movie. Deathridge stated he does not recall anything specific about Walters turning off the TV. Deathridge did not know how long the content had been on the TV when he noticed it but believed it was during the first witness of the executive session. Deathridge believed that when Walters left the meeting to get the second (2nd) witness he would see what was on the TV and turn it off. Deathridge denied claims that he was thinking of taking a picture of the TV. Deathridge stated he never saw Fox News on the TV this day. Deathridge stated he did not notice anything significant about the TV while they were getting lunch. He stated he was accustomed to it being on because it was usually on Fox News. A short while later the interview was concluded.
